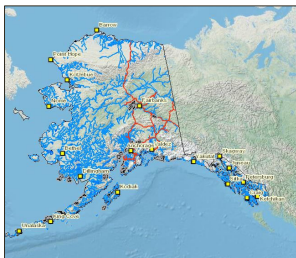
Is a permit required?

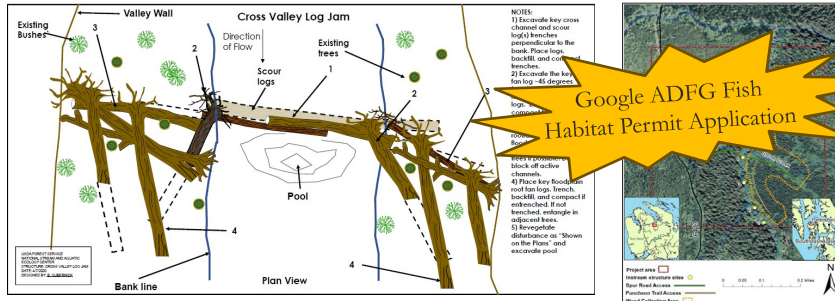
